Trust me, we have turned over more stones to find the elusive underwriter that would write us a policy. So VA4WDA and Wheelin' for Hope are in the same boat. Both teams, along with Trail Experience and Oak Ridge

Estate are still researching and calling every lead to find insurance for both events next year. We welcome any leads that you may have but trust me we probably have contacted them.

I want to thank those that have worked hard to try to make this happen, but at this time we couldn't put things together at this late date to put on the event that everyone expects. Again, we want to thank all of those that have supported us and participated in all past events. Without all of you, this wouldn't be a quality event.

Potatoes

Sausage or breakfast meat of your choice

Eggs

Green Chile (Any chile you desire)

Salt / Pepper

Seasoning

Tortillas (or buscuit, pita, etc...)

Preparation:

Potatoes – Slice with grater or cut into thin slices

Sausage or bacon – crumble sausage; cut bacon into 1x2 squares

- · Add Olive Oil (your choice) to disk and heat
- · Add meat cook meat then add potatoes
- · Cook meat and potatoes till done and add green chile
- Season to taste
- Add eggs (depending on how many you are feeding, picture above had a dozen eggs; feeding 15 people)
- When done heat up a tortilla on the disk for a great handheld breakfast burrito or serve with your favorite jelly/jam and biscuits.



Capital City Four Wheelers 39th Annual Surf Fishing Tournament

October 19, 2024 - October 20, 2024

The 3rd full weekend in October will be here before you know it. CCFW will again host our annual saltwater surf fishing tournament on the Outer Banks of North Carolina. This event is fun for all ages with regular entries qualifying for big winnings and door prizes, as well as a free children's tournament with prizes of their own. It is once again an individual fisherman tournament, with a chance at the money for the biggest and second biggest Red Drum, Blue Fish, Trout, Northern Puffer, Sea Mullet, Croaker, or Spot. We have prizes totaling over \$2350, which is an increase of \$450 since 2022.

We continue to be blessed by the local Outer Banks businesses as well as businesses in Virginia, with 100's of door prizes to be given away. Prizes for food and dining are held via Facebook live, via entry the Friday prior to the first day of fishing. When entrants arrive to pick up their tournament packet, they could be pleasantly surprised to find a "Door Prize Winner" sticker on their packet. Tournament Entries that make it in the tournament PO Box by 9/1/24 will receive a free tournament t-shirt with their entry. Our club continues to promote cleaning up our outdoor spaces, with a trash pickup contest with a chance at a prize valued at least \$100. Thanks to the wonderful folks at Hatteras Jacks, Carolina Casting Pro, and One More Cast at least one Custom Rod and Reel Combo will be raffled off to fund LOCAL island charitable organization(s). None of these contests and donations would be possible without all the fishing men and women who enter our tournament! We love seeing the next generation carrying the torch of responsible fishermen/women, so bring them along to fish too and have a chance at their own prizes.

Entry forms were mailed out at the beginning of July, if you didn't receive one, they can be downloaded from our web site at https://www.capitalcityfourwheelersva.com/our-services. You can also enter on the day of the Tournament, in the morning, Saturday, October 19th, at the Fessenden Center in Buxton (bring cash). It's better to enter ahead of time, preferably before September 1st, to get a free t-shirt and be entered for the Saturday morning door prizes. Don't forget to get on the list for next year.
